A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE SAUK COUNTY HAZARD MITIGATION PLAN: 2025-2029

WHEREAS, the United States Congress passed the Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (DMA2K), which requires that a local unit of government must have an approved all hazard mitigation plan before it can receive Federal grant monies from the Federal Emergency Management Agency for pre-disaster mitigation projects; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Reedsburg worked with Sauk County Emergency Management to update the countywide mitigation plan, initially adopted in 2006; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Reedsburg conducted a public hearing on October 13, 2025, to accept public input concerning the updated plan; and

WHEREAS, the Town of Reedsburg makes the following findings:

- 1. Natural disasters do pose a tangible threat to residents and property.
- 2. Undertaking hazard mitigation actions before disasters occur will reduce the potential for harm to residents and property and save taxpayer dollars.
- 3. Preparation of this plan is in the public interest.
- 4. This plan is intended to serve as a general strategy and may be amended from time to time.
- 5. Nothing in this plan obligates the Town of Reedsburg] to undertake any of the recommended activities and/or projects.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Town of Reedsburg hereby adopts the Sauk County Hazard Mitigation Plan: 2025-2029; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Town of Reedsburg Clerk is directed to send a signed copy of this resolution, at their earliest convenience, to Sauk County Emergency Management, at 510 Broadway, Baraboo, WI 53913.
